

Match the Sound Activity Card

It's a classic pairing game – but with focusing on matching the sounds. If you child enjoys this game, you can make more bottles with different objects inside to match!



WHAT DO I NEED

- 1.2 bottles partially filled with water
- 2.2 bottles partially filled with pebbles
- 3.2 bottles partially filled rice (you can get your child involved in making the bottles)
- 4. A screen to hide bottles behind

METHOD

- 1. Sit on the floor with your child opposite you and explore the bottle sounds together
- 2. Put a small screen in front of you (this could be a large tray on its side or an empty box)
- 3. In front of the screen place one bottle filled with water, one filled with pebbles and another filled with rice
- 4. Put the matching set of bottles behind the screen out of sight of your child and ask them to listen
- 5. From behind the screen and out of site of your child shake one of the bottles
- 6. Can your child find the matching bottle from their set in front of the screen?
- 7. You can then increase the difficulty by creating a sequence of sounds and ask your child to repeat the sequence
- 8. Let your child have a turn of making the sound or sequence and you match it
